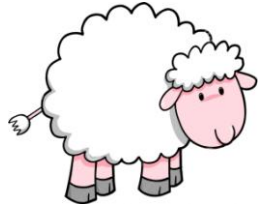

All Entry forms are due by July 1st. Animals will be accepted on a space available basis after that and entry fees will be double.

All Exhibitors are responsible for knowing and meeting all Animal Health Requirements. See website for further details.

- All animals must arrive and adhere to Animal Check-In Policy with the NYS Veterinarian on site.
- All animals must have Veterinary inspection before competing.
- All animals must be in place by noon on Tuesday of fair week and will be released at 8:00 pm on Saturday. Early departure will result in premium forfeiture, unless granted by barn superintendent.
- Judge's decisions are final.
- All Exhibitors are expected to participate in the cleaning of the barn, date to be scheduled by barn superintendent.

ENTRY FEE – 10% of the first-place premium per animal for each class entered, and one for each group class. Exhibitor weekly parking pass is available for \$15 per vehicle.

- All sheep exhibited for premiums, including market lambs, must have been owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to fair.
- An exhibitor may enter as many animals as desired in any class, but cannot receive more than two premiums in each single class, or more than one premium in each group class.
- All sheep must be shown in individual classes to be eligible to compete in group classes.
- A maximum of 60 sheep may be exhibited by each family, or less if space is limited.
- Market lambs can be ewes, rams, or wethers, purebred or cross-bred, but may not have been shown in any Breed classes.
- Senior lambs are those born on or after Sept.1 and Junior lambs are those born after Jan 1.
- Flock shall consist of 1 ram any age, 1 yearling ewe and 2 ewe lambs.
