

# **PACKET FOR ENTRY**

## Team Entry Instructions, Race Details, Race Info & Guidelines, Waiver/Release/Permission to Photograph Form, Pledge Sheet

- Register your teams on-line at <u>www.FamilyPromiseOntarioCounty.org/bed-race-fpoc</u>. Click on the <u>Live</u> <u>Race Registration</u> button. This will take you to the Bed Race GiveGab Page. Click on the <u>Start</u> <u>Fundraising</u> button. This will guide you in creating an online page for your team to collect online donations.
- 2. Email the information requested on page 2 by Friday, July 7<sup>th</sup> to <u>fpoccem@fpocny.org</u> Bring the signed waivers and pledge/donation sheets to the Bed Race the day of the event. EACH TEAM MEMBER must complete the paperwork. This information is important for the day of the event to run smoothly and for your team to get the **proper recognition and press coverage**! The registration fee this year is \$50.
- 3. <u>Any MINORS (under 18 years of age) must have the Waiver/Photo/Release Form signatures signed with a legal guardian.</u>
- 4. The day of the event your team/bed will be assigned a parking space for judging. A Bed Monitor will be assigned to your team who will be responsible to verify all the team documents <u>BEFORE</u> getting you registered. It is recommended you are ready at 6:00 PM for Registration, which your Bed Monitor will lead you through.
- 5. The person riding in the bed will be weighed to assure he/she meets the minimum weight requirements.
- 6. ALL members of the team <u>MUST</u> be with the bed for judging and team pictures.
- 7. All beds must be removed post-race unless you decide to leave your bed for display at the fair. If this is your desire, please remove your bed from the fairgrounds by Saturday afternoon.
- 8. You can compete for the MOST MONEY RAISED award by doing the following:
  - Solicit **pledges** from individuals using the sheet provided on the last page of this packet. Collect, tabulate and submit money in an envelope during registration on the day of the race.
  - Find **local businesses** to sponsor your team and list them on your pledge sheet! If you find businesses that wish to donate more than \$200, contact the Bed Race Chairperson at <a href="mailto:fpoccem@gmail.com">fpoccem@gmail.com</a> so they may be recognized as an official FPOC Bed Race Sponsor, if they wish.
  - An award for PEOPLE'S CHOICE is run by FPOC on race day. The bed team whose **fans and race day attendees** donate the most \$ to that day win the award. This amount will be added to the two bullets above to determine the award for MOST MONEY RAISED by a bed team. Drum up supporters to come cheer you on and join in the fun!!!!

# **RACE DETAILS**

- 1. Five-person teams. Age 12 and up only.
- Entry Fee: \$50 per team Deadline to enter is Friday, July 1<sup>st</sup>. Space is limited to first 20 beds.
- 3. Team Divisions: (All teams may be combined into the Road Hog Division if not enough have entered separate divisions)
  - ➤ Hot Wheels (ages 12 to 17) Rider must be at least 12 years old and weigh at least 75 lbs. Every team member must be between 12-17 years old.
  - Road Hogs (ages 18+) Rider and team members must be at least 18 years old, and rider must weigh at least 100 lbs.
  - Savvy Big-league (ages 31+) Rider and team members must be at least 31 years old, and rider must weigh at least 100 lbs.
  - ➤ Sunday Drivers (runners ages 50+) Rider and team members must be 50+ and weigh a minimum of 100 lbs. Every team member must be 50+ years old.
- 4. Transform a bed into a racing vehicle to enter using Bed Construction Guidelines on Page 4
- 5. Awards for:
  - ➤ Fastest Bed (By Division)
  - ➤ Crowd Favorite

➤ Most Money Raised by Team (this combines the team pledge sheet on page 7 with the amount raised in the Virtual Event by your team)

# **RACING INFO & GUIDELINES**

## **Bed Construction Guidelines:**

- 1. Teams are responsible for entry fee and all construction costs.
- 2. Beds must be at least 3 feet by 6 feet in area. For safety reasons, beds cannot be made out of particle wood or particleboard.
- 3. Beds must have either a box spring OR a mattress and must lie flat in the bed frame. No air mattresses.
- 4. Push Bars (handles) are allowed but may not extend more than 16 inches from the bed frame. Handles must be designed for safety, with no sharp or jagged edges.
- 5. Beds must have four wheels suitable for a clay track (\_\_\_minimum width; 4-inch minimum diameter). All four wheels must have contact with the ground at the finish line. All wheels must be load bearing but do not have to be the same size.
- 6. No bed may have motorized or mechanical means of motion. All means of motion shall be limited to race team members.
- 7. Steering mechanisms may be used.
- 8. The bed must be constructed in a fashion that all pushers are able to see the course from the front of the bed. *Examples:*



# **RACING INFO & GUIDELINES (con't)**

## **Team Rules:**

- 1. Five (5) people per team. Substitutions are not allowed once the team checks in on Race Day. Teams can make a rider/runner switch before any heat as long as the rider meets age and weight requirements for that team category.
- 2. The rider must be riding on the bed for the entire heat.
- 3. Riders MUST wear helmet or protective headgear. All team members must wear closed-toe shoes. Knee and elbow pads are encouraged.
- 4. All four runners must be in contact with the bed when crossing the finish line to qualify.
- 5. No alcoholic beverages allowed during the race.
- 6. Failure to report for bed inspection prior to race time will result in a disqualification and forfeiture of entry fee.
- 7. Every team member MUST sign a waiver/photograph/release form.

## **Racing Information:**

- 1. The Race will be a straight run on The Land of Legends Raceway, a clay race track at the Ontario County Fairgrounds. The race will be approximately 150 yards in length. All races will be run in heats of two beds each. Heats and lanes will be chosen prior to race day registration. When the bed arrives it will be assigned a specific staging location.
- 2. Bed crews should deliver their bed to the race track pit area off of County Road 10. The delivery vehicle can remain there throughout the race. Other team members should park in the general parking area.
- 3. The two bed racing will both line up at the Start Line.
- 4. Each Race Team will stay in their lane throughout the race. Should a team leave their assigned lane and interfere with another Team, the imposing Team will be disqualified and the interfered Team will have the option of a restart.
- 5. Each Bed will receive a time for crossing the finish line. The fastest Teams from each category will receive a prize.
- 6. After the Bed Race, teams may either leave their beds set up at the Fair, or bring them home. Any beds left at the Fair must be picked up by Saturday afternoon.

### WAIVER, RELEASE & PERMISSION TO PHOTOGRAPH

1. Applicants age 18 and over, complete Part A & C only.

2.Applicants age under 18 must have parent or guardian complete Parts A, B and C.

3.ALL Applicants/Racers must complete this form and bring proof of identification on race day.

#### Part A WAIVER & RELEASE FROM LIABILITY

As set forth below, the undersigned participant hereby voluntarily waives and releases all claims, and prospective claims for any and all damage or injury connected to the participant's participation in, involvement with, or association with the 2022 Bed Race. Further, the participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Family Promise of Ontario County, Inc., and other releases as detailed below.

In consideration of being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (herein defined as the areas to which admissions by general public spectators is prohibited), or being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for or for any purpose participate in any way in the event, the undersigned participant, for themselves, his/her personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, acknowledges, agrees and represents that he/she has or will immediately upon entering any of such restricted areas, and will continuously thereafter, inspect such restricted area or areas and his/her participation, if any, in the event constitutes an acknowledgement that he/she has inspected such restricted area and has reviewed the conditions, requirements and the location of the event, and that he/she finds and accepts the same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of his/her use and he/ she further agrees and warrants that if at any time, he/she is in or about restricted areas or the location of the event and he/she feels anything to be unsafe, he/she will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the restricted area(s) and/or will withdraw from the event.

### 1. The undersigned participant HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE

Family Promise of Ontario County, Ontario County Consolidated Governments, City of Canandaigua, the promoters and sponsors, other participants, operators, assigns, heirs and the next of kin (The Releases) for any and all damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise while the undersigned is in or upon the restricted area, and/or competing, officiating in, observing or working for, or for any purpose participating in the event or related activities. 2. The undersigned participant HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in or upon the restricted area or in any way competing, officiating, observing or working for or for any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.

3. The undersigned participant HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILTY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OF PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of releases or otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing or working for or for any purpose participating in the event.

4. The undersigned participant EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED expressly acknowledges and agrees that the activities at the event and in the restricted area are dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. EACH OF THE UN-DERSIGNED in Part A and Part B of the waiver and release further expressly agrees that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of New York and that if any portion therefore is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

THE UNDERSIGNED PARTICIPANT HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIA-BILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements of inducements apart from the forgoing written agreement have been made.

This waiver, release and indemnification agreement specifically embraces each and every event sanction, authorized or promoted by said Releasees during the entire <sup>2022</sup> Bed Race in which the undersigned participates so that the parties herein intended to be released and indemnified shall be fully and effectively released and indemnified as to each and every event hereinabove described.
