TYPE: Dead Boat

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per driver for first class entered (includes admission for 1 participant and 1 helper) Each additional class \$10 - limit 2 weight classes depending on the number of tractors)

CLASS: 4500, 5500, 6500, 8000

RULES

Stock tractors and enhanced (subject to judge's approval).

Entries limited to models in production by 1956.

Only standard gas, diesel, or kerosene will be allowed as fuel.

No tractor shall exceed more than 200 RPM over factory specs.

All tractors will use original factory drawbars or facsimile thereof.

All drawbars will be mounted rigid in all directions. Drawbars shall be no closer than 20 inches from center of rear axle housing and no higher than 19 inches from pulling surface.

Front end can not exceed 24 inches off from ground.

Drivers must remain seated at all times.

All stock tractors must pull in low gear; first or second for enhanced.

All weights must be secured to tractor. If weights or any object should fall off during the pull, tractor puller is automatically disqualified.

Maximum tire size for stock classes as follows: 4500 – 5500 classes – 13.6, 6500 class – 15.5, 8000 class – 18.4. No radials, no altered tires, and absolutely no cut/sharpened tires or altered rims for stock classes.

No steel wheels. Wheelie bars are recommended for all classes.

No weight will be past front wheel for stock classes.

All tractors will be in neutral, hands and feet clear of all controls, while hooking and unhooking.

Use of alcoholic beverages will result in disqualification.

Driver will pull the load forward until forward motion stops or is flagged by track officials.

No operator under the age of 14. Operators between 14 and 18 must have written consent from parent or guardian. An adult must accompany drivers under 16.

No sign-ups accepted after class has started.

Date of manufacture will be determined by dealer provided serial numbers if necessary.

First three places in each class will be reweighed at finish of class.

Decision of track officials and rules committee will be final.
